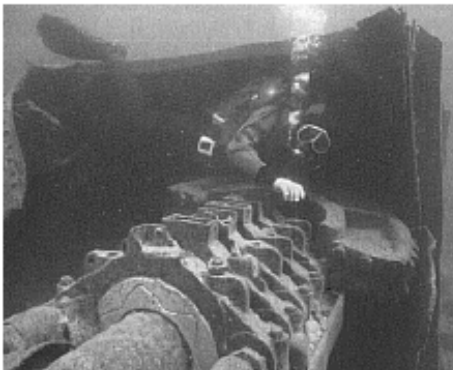
### News Flash
